

Your safety is our primary concern. It is important that you feel safe and secure when you are using your Lifestyle Homelift, we have:

- Fire protection between the upper and lower floors, whether the lift is parked upstairs or downstairs, to the requirements of BS5900: 2012
- UKCA and CE marked to conform with the Machinery Directive
- Building control approval obtained for every installation
- A load capacity of 250kg (39 stone)

- 12 month warranty
- Manual lowering function and battery back-up allowing in-car lowering to the ground floor in the event of a power outage, so lone occupants can use the lift in complete confidence
- Dedicated aftercare support team to assist you with using your lift


Pressure sensitive safety surfaces stop the lift if obstructed from above or below


Slim and Stylish, the Terry Lifestyle Lift has a small footprint and will fit discreetly almost anywhere in your home.

Frequently asked QUESTIONS

Is it possible for the lift to stop between floors when I am on my own?

In the unlikely event that a power cut occurs at your property, the lift's main batteries will maintain control and lower the lift safely to the ground floor. If this system fails, our unique in-car Auxiliary Battery Lowering will take over. This works in the same way as the main circuit but isolates any potentially faulty operating circuits without compromising the safety of the user or other occupants within the property.

Should both systems fail, with assistance, a manually operated lowering system can be activated from outside the lift to bring you safely to the ground floor.

For added reassurance, our lift can be equipped with an in-car telephone, connected to your property's landline.

Can I use my wheelchair in a Lifestyle Homelift?

No, however, we have designed the Harmony and Harmony FE lifts in collaboration with our customers to meet the requirements of a wheelchair user or an attended wheelchair user. Illustrated on the back of this brochure.

Does Terry Lifts manage the building work?

Yes, we can complete all building work or alternatively, we can provide a Specification Guide to your builder. The choice is yours. Normally, no major structural work is required.

How much space does a Lifestyle Homelift require?

The footprint of the Lifestyle Homelift is smaller than that of a typical armchair. Please refer to size diagram above or we can provide a footprint template to position in your home.

Is the Lifestyle Homelift safe in the event of a fire?

The Lifestyle Homelift is fire and smoke test certificated by an approved and accredited test laboratory and complies with BS5900:2012 in relation to through floor lifts. This covers fire safety for the Lifestyle Homelift in both the lower and upper position.

I plan to keep my lift for a very long time, will Terry Lifts service and care for my lift?

Yes. Terry Lifts can provide a service and maintenance package to suit your requirements. Please contact our aftercare service team to discuss options that are available.

Can installing a Lifestyle Homelift be cheaper than moving home?

Yes, almost certainly. We are often told by our customers that it was cheaper and less stressful than moving home.
